

## **Brush Pick Up Policy**

All tree trimming contractors/companies must visit Town Hall to apply for a <u>Commercial Tree Removal and Trimming Permit prior</u> to beginning work. The cost of the permit is five dollars (\$5.00) and serves to protect the homeowner and contractor. Tree trimmings and cutting debris created by private companies and/or contractors <u>must</u> be removed by the company and disposed of off-site. In the event the brush is not disposed of, it will be the homeowner's responsibility for the disposal.

Trimmings created by the homeowner will be collected at least once per week in each neighborhood. Only trimmings that are 6" in diameter or smaller and that are less than 12' long will be picked up. Grass clippings, leaves, or other material that can be raked must be placed in bags. No other materials shall be placed in with the brush.

In the event of any delays, a paper door knocker will be placed on the door of the homeowner to inform of the issue and a potential collection date.
